Program Eligibility

Money + Mentorship

- 18 – 39 years old
 - Students in final year before graduating & Newcomers
- 0 – 12 months full-time operations
- Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident
- Credit Check Eligible
- Business Plan & Financial Projections

Start-up Program

The Money

- Up to \$45,000 (\$15k + \$30k BDC)
- Character-based (unsecured!)
- Flexible 5-year repayment schedule
- Interest only (no principal) payments in Year 1

The Mentor

- 2 years of custom-matched one-on-one mentorship

Side Hustle

The **Money**

- Set loans of \$5,000, \$10,000, or \$15,000
- Character-based (unsecured!)
- 3-year repayment schedule
- Based on disposable income to service loan

The **Mentor**

- 2 years of custom-matched one-on-one mentorship
