RE: SANITARY AND STORM SERVICE JUNCTIONS - MANUFACTURED WYES ONLY

Please be advised that the Manual of Engineering Standards and Specifications (MoESS) Sections 6.24 and 7.23 require manufactured wyes for sanitary and storm sewer service junctions (with the exclusion of concrete), including tie ins to existing, unless otherwise approved by the City Engineer.

Due to the increasing number of requests, the City has updated the Approved Products List to note that saddles are only to be used in extenuation circumstances and with permission from the City Engineer.

Instances where it has been found that pipe saddles have been installed without written approval, the City will be taking one or a combination of the following approaches:

- 1. Require removal and reinstatement with an acceptable installation.
- 2. Require extended warranty periods for materials in question including extension of bonding related to the installation
- 3. Permanently withhold payment on the installation
- 4. Withhold payment as a holdback until the end of the warranty period.
