



SELF GUIDED SCENARIOS WORKSHOP PRIZE DRAW TERMS AND CONDITIONS

PLEASE READ THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS CAREFULLY. BY ENTERING THE CITY OF NANAIMO REIMAGINE NANAIMO SCENARIOS PRIZE DRAW (THE “PRIZE DRAW”), THE ENTRANT AGREES TO BE BOUND BY ALL THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS CONTAINED HEREIN. IF YOU DO NOT AGREE TO ALL OF THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS, DO NOT ENTER THE PRIZE DRAW. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS MAY RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION AND/OR NULLIFY THE ENTRANT FROM PARTICIPATING IN THE PRIZE DRAW.

ELIGIBILITY AND PARTICIPATION

To be eligible for the Prize Draw, an individual must be (a) a legal resident of the Province of British Columbia, (b) regularly spend time in Nanaimo (living, working, going to school), and (c) 13 years of age or older. If the winner drawn bears a minor’s name, the prize will be lawfully delivered on behalf of the minor to the minor’s parent, legal guardian, or trustee.

Employees of the City of Nanaimo (“Nanaimo”), its subsidiaries and its contractors, as well as family members of such employees, and household members who reside at the same address as such employees are not eligible for the Prize Draw.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS AND PRIZE DRAW DEADLINES

The Prize Draw Entry will open on Tuesday, August 24, 2021 at 9 a.m. Pacific Standard Time (PST) and all entries must be received by **11:59 p.m. PST on Monday, September 20, 2021.**

To enter the Prize Draw, entrants must complete and submit a **REIMAGINE NANAIMO Self Guided Workshop** by doing the following:

- Online through submitting their input on the Metroquest Phase 2 Self-Guided Workshop Website, which will take you to the prize entry form hosted on the City’s website at www.nanaimo.ca/get-involved/community-engagement/reimagine-nanaimo-phase2-scenarios-self

Only one entry per person will be accepted. All subsequent entries will be disqualified. Entries received by any other method will not be accepted.

The City of Nanaimo and its subsidiaries are not responsible or liable for any potential entrant’s inability to access the submission process. The City of Nanaimo and its subsidiaries are not responsible for lost, late, damaged, illegible, garbled, stolen, misdirected, misidentified, delayed, or incomplete entries, for any problems or technical or mechanical malfunction of the computer online systems, servers, access providers, computer equipment, software, failure of any entry to be received by the City of Nanaimo on account of technical problems or traffic congestion on the internet or at any website, or inaccurate entry information, whether caused by equipment, programming used in this prize draw, human processing or otherwise, or any combination thereof.

PRIZE

Chances of winning depend on the number of entries received. Qualified entrants are eligible to win ONE:

- One hundred (\$100) dollar gift certificate to a Nanaimo eatery of their choice.

SELECTION OF WINNING ENTRIES AND WINNER NOTIFICATION

The winning entry will be chosen randomly from all qualified entries the week of November 1, 2021.

The selected winner will be notified by the City of Nanaimo within 48 hours of the draw via telephone or email as provided by the entrant at the time of entry.

The selected winner will be required to acknowledge via email his/her receipt of the notification of eligibility for the prize. If no response is received by the City of Nanaimo within five (5) business days of initial notification, the prize will be forfeited and an alternate winner from the remaining eligible entries will be selected.

To be declared a winner, the selected winner must:

- (a) First correctly answer, unaided, a time-limited, skill-testing question;
- (b) Sign a release form, in a form acceptable to the City of Nanaimo;
- (c) Sign a certificate acknowledging receipt of the prize; and
- (d) Consent to the announcement of his/her/they name and the use of his/her/they name, city of residence, photograph, likenesses, voice and statements by the City of Nanaimo for advertising and promotional purposes without any expectation of remuneration or compensation.

If the selected winner fails to meet these conditions within 7 days of acknowledging his/her receipt of the notification of eligibility for the prize, the prize will be forfeited. The City of Nanaimo may then select an alternate Entrant in accordance with these Rules. The City of Nanaimo will not have any liability whatsoever to the first selected Entrant in connection with his or her non-compliance with the Rules or failure to sign the above-noted documents.
