September to October 2016

Feasibility Assessment

November to December 2016

- Public and stakeholder engagement (to inform Council of the public's overall interest in the project)
- Detailed site analysis, traffic impact, environmental assessments
- **Economic Impact Study**
- **Detailed Feasibility Assessment and Business Case**
- December 19, 2016, Council receives Feasibility Assessment

Decision Points:

- Staff provides a report to Council recommending next steps based on findings of Feasibility Assessment
- Council considers next steps and, if they choose to, direct staff to proceed to Phase 3









How it will be built

Detailed Design, Financing and Procurement Framework and Legal Agreements

January to March 2017

- Public and stakeholder engagement (to inform Council of the public's position on facility programming, design, financing options)
- Detailed design
- Financing and operations framework
- Legal agreements, construction, operations and maintenance, facility leases, electoral approval of project financing (referendum*), borrowing bylaw if required

Decision Points:

- Staff provides a number of reports recommending next steps regarding: procurement and financing framework, electoral approval process and public engagement, detailed design approval, project management and legal agreements
- Council considers next steps and, if they choose to, directs staff to proceed to Phase 4



How to fund it

Electoral Approval Process

February to March 2017

- Public engagement (to inform the public of options to participate in electoral approval referendum*
 and communicate the project financing framework)
- Hold electoral approval process

Decision Points:

- Council receives results of electoral approval process
- Council considers financial implications of the outcome of the electoral approval process
- Based on Council's considerations, directs staff to proceed to Phase 5
