By signing this form, you declare that you are **opposed** to the establishment of the Downtown Nanaimo Association Business Improvement Area. The *Community Charter* provides that the Business Improvement Area will **not proceed** if more than 50% of the property owners in the area, representing more than 50% of the assessed value according to the last Assessment Roll, give notice in writing that they object to the renewal, between October 30, 2025, and November 28, 2025.

Note: If the property has multiple owners, the owners representing at least 50% of ownership must sign a form. **The deadline for submitting a petition against is on Friday, November 28, 2025, at 4:30pm.**
