1.0 GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1.1. **PURPOSE:** To provide a written, formal policy stating terms of reference and objectives of the Vancouver Island Emergency Response Academy Director.
- 1.2. **RESPONSIBILITY:** It is the responsibility of the Academy Director to be familiar with this guideline and to ensure that all representatives sitting on the Advisory Committee be given an orientation and supplied with a copy of this Operational Guideline.

2.0 ACADEMY DIRECTOR

2.1. The Academy Director will be the Nanaimo Fire Rescue Fire Chief or designate and will be the chair of the VIERA Advisory Committee.

3.0 TERMS OF REFERENCE

- 3.1. To determine the scope and service the Academy will offer.
- 3.2. Approve Policies, Procedures and Operational Guidelines to meet Pro Board criteria and govern the Academy operations.
- 3.3. Approve Operating and Capital Budget.
- 3.4. Identify stakeholder groups that should be offered representation on the Advisory Committee.
- 3.5. Provide direction to the Advisory Committee.
- 3.6. Make decisions on the Advisory Committee recommendations.
- 3.7. Ensure Pro Board accreditation status is maintained.
- 3.8. Select qualified applicants for Instructor, Evaluator and Proctor positions.
- 3.9. Set Instructor remuneration rates and course tuition fees.
- 3.10. Dismiss Instructors, Evaluators and Proctors if, and when, required.
- 3.11. Address Instructor, Evaluator and Proctor performance and/or disciplinary issues.
- 3.12. Rule on any student appeals and/or disputes.
