Hazardous Materials/WMD NFPA 470



Hazmat Awareness

Detect, collect, connect, protect. This 4-hour **online** course is designed for anyone who may encounter a hazardous materials incident during the course of their work. Students learn to detect the presence of hazardous materials, collect information from the available sources, connect with the appropriate resources and protect first responders and the public from harm.

Incident Safety Officer NFPA 1550



Prepare to take on the **critical role of Incident Safety Officer (ISO) at emergency scenes.** This 3-day course examines the ISO role and responsibilities focusing on operations within the Incident Command System (ICS). Students learn to evaluate scenes for safety concerns across all hazards, analyze risks, recommend solutions and communicate effectively with the Incident Commander. Leave with the skills and confidence to keep crews safe when it matters most. Experience with ESM and ICS is important for success in this course.
