

# WATERING RESTRICTIONS GUIDE

## **STAGE 1 – April and October**

- Watering Days: Any day
- Permitted Times: 7:00 PM – 7:00 AM
- Applies To: Lawn watering, vehicle/boat/house washing, hand watering/drip irrigation, filling pools/fountains/hot tubs, and pressure washing
- New Lawns: Permits allowed

## **STAGE 2 – May to September**

- Watering Days: Every other day  
*(Even addresses on even-numbered days; odd addresses on odd-numbered days)*
- Permitted Times: 7:00–10:00 AM or 7:00–10:00 PM *(maximum 2 hours a day)*
- Applies To: Lawn watering, washing vehicles/boats/houses, filling pools/fountains/hot tubs, and pressure washing
- Hand Watering & Drip Irrigation: anytime on your assigned watering day
- New Lawns: Permits allowed

## **STAGE 3 – As required, Voluntary Outdoor Restrictions**

- Watering Days: One day per week  
*(Odd addresses: Monday; even addresses: Thursday)*
- Permitted Times: 7:00–10:00 AM or 7:00–10:00 PM *(maximum 2 hours a day)*
- Applies To: Lawn watering, washing vehicles/boats/ house siding  
*(only during permitted times on your assigned day)*
- Voluntary Reductions: Hand watering/drip irrigation, filling pools/fountains/hot tubs, and pressure washing - residents are encouraged to reduce use where possible to avoid a comprehensive watering ban.

## **STAGE 4- As required, Comprehensive Watering Ban**

- Not Permitted: Lawn watering, filling pools/fountains/hot tubs
- Limited Use: Washing vehicles/boats/house siding  
*(once per week on your Stage 3 watering day)*
- Pressure Washing: Only permitted prior to applying paint, preservative, stucco, or sealant  
*(once per week on your Stage 3 watering day)*
- New Lawns: No permits issued

*EXEMPTION: Vegetable gardens and fruit trees are exempt from all watering restrictions.*
