

PROCLAMATION NANAIMO & WORLD RIVERS DAY September 27, 2015

WHEREAS: rivers are a vital part of our natural environment—upon which every living

thing is dependent; and

WHEREAS: rivers have played significant roles throughout the history of habitation on

Earth—for the well-being of plants and wildlife, and for both indigenous

peoples and more recent human migration and settlement; and

WHEREAS: governments at all levels recognize the importance and significance of rivers for

environmental, economic and recreation values, and desire to preserve this

resource in its natural state; and

WHEREAS: in 2005, the United Nations declared the Water for Life decade, and

incorporated World Rivers Day into its list of events; and since then, millions of

people around the world annually celebrate their local rivers; and

WHEREAS: the Nanaimo River Watershed Roundtable, an organization of private and

public watershed stewards, strives to encourage a greater awareness of the value of the Nanaimo River and all other rivers in this region as an essential and

precious resource; and

WHEREAS: World Rivers Day, which falls on Sunday, September 27th this year, provides an

opportunity to acknowledge and celebrate river systems and watersheds—both locally and world-wide—and to reflect on what we stand to lose should we fail

to take care of them.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Bill McKay, Mayor of the City of Nanaimo, do hereby proclaim September

27th, 2015, be known as:
