

PROCLAMATION

BLACK HISTORY MONTH February 2021

- WHEREAS: Black History Month was first proposed by the leaders of the Black United Students at Kent State University in February 1969, and the first celebration of Black History Month tock place at Kent State one year later; and
- WHEREAS: Black History Month was first celebrated in the United Kingdom in 1987 and in 1995, Canada's House of Commons officially recognized February as Black History Month. In 2008, the Senate officially recognized Black History Month, which was unanimously approved; and
- by designating February each year as Black History Month, the City will WHEREAS: acknowledge and honour the important contributions made by Black Pioneers who settled in this area 150 years ago.
