

PROCLAMATION

ECONOMIC ABUSE AWARENESS DAY November 26, 2023

WHEREAS: domestic Economic Abuse is a common but overlooked form of domestic violence that limits an individual's financial autonomy, including denying

access and control over resources or constraining economic freedom; and

WHEREAS: barriers to economic resources undermine a survivor's independence,

including the ability to flee abusive relationships. Economic Abuse has detrimental effects on a survivor's mental and physical well~being and

other social determinants of health; and

WHEREAS: Economic Abuse happens across socio-economic status, race, and age and

is exacerbated by intersectional and systemic factors; and

WHEREAS: Economic Abuse survivors have the right to be free from violence and must

feel empowered to regain control over their lives; and

WHEREAS: all levels of government must work to prevent Economic Abuse; and

WHEREAS: the city of Nanaimo commits to supporting victim~survivors of Economic

Abuse and encourages everyone to inform themselves about the signs and

impacts of Economic Abuse.
